### Working Bills

Almost 3 weeks into the 2nd, 30th Legislative session and things are moving right along. My office is prime sponsor on HB 263 Transportation services for hunters, which had its 1st hearing on February 1st. I have also co-sponsored other legislation that I feel is important to District 30. Co-sponsored bills include Rep. Saddler's HB 260 Fish & game licenses; electronic form, Rep. Tuck's HB 269 Distillery licenses, service on premises, Rep. Saddler's HB 270 Prohibit aircraft registration and Rep. Wool's HB 301 Alcohol license; beverage dispensary/restaurant (BDL tourism license). If you are interested in keeping up to date on the movement of any bills you can enroll in SMS bill tracking by texting a bill number (example HB1) to 559-245-2529 to start receiving text alerts.
